



## COMMUNITY ACCESS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

OBS is a Community Organization that's recognized by the UCLA Extension Writers' Program.

The [UCLA Extension Writer's Program](#) is pleased to announce the 2008-2009 Community Access Scholarship Program. As a participant of this program, OBS take advantage of this scholarship valued at approximately \$1,200 annually by awarding it to a well-deserving OBS member.

The Community Access Scholarship Program furthers the literary arts in Los Angeles by providing select non-profit organizations, OBS, with an opportunity to identify a beginning-to-emerging writer to receive a scholarship. The scholarship consists of complimentary enrollments into three Writers' Program courses (except Master Classes, advanced courses, Writers Studio workshops, and some courses that are closed or expected to fill) over the 2008-2009 academic year (fall through summer).

In 1991 the [UCLA Extension Writers' Program](#), in cooperation with over 20 community arts groups, established the Community Access Scholarship Program. The goal of the Program is to work in partnership with community arts organizations to provide scholarships to aspiring writers from diverse backgrounds and cultures who might otherwise not have the opportunity to develop their craft in a supportive classroom setting.

### WHO CAN APPLY

To apply for this the Community Access Scholarship you must be an OBS member in good standing living in Los Angeles County and an active member of an *OBS sanctioned Writer's Group*. You must be able to attend classes this fall.

### HOW TO APPLY

To apply for consideration for this scholarship, you must submit a writing sample. you The sample can be one of the following:

**Spec Script** of a currently running show, ½ hour or 1-hour that includes the teaser and first two acts; no more than 20 pages.

Or

**Feature Film script** that includes 1-page synopsis, Logline, character analysis of no more than four main characters with the first 13 pages of the script only.

Pages can be stapled but must be in the correct format with a cover sheet with your name, title, and contact information.

Please **do not** put your name on the script.

Scripts must be submitted and received (not postmarked) no later than Monday, August 18<sup>th</sup>.
